



THE SPACE FOR INNOVATION

The Gulf & Ship Island Building is a collaborative workspace for blue tech innovation located in the Gulfport Blue Economy Innovation District. Entrepreneurs and startups developing solutions to global challenges come here to capitalize on existing, world-class ocean research capabilities and connect to research scientists, prototyping, fabrication, laboratories, evaluation services and proximity to the Port of Gulfport, rail, interstates, and the Gulfport-Biloxi International Airport. Life in the Gulf & Ship Island Building also includes proximity to small businesses and industry and an extensive mentor network as well as local, state, and federal partners—all within steps of the Gulf of Mexico, which includes year-round shallow- and deep-water testing. If you are working in the blue economy, you will not find another location with greater access to resources or a higher quality of life.











FIRST FLOOR

Space at the GSI Building is currently available through a variety of membership options. Basic memberships start at \$240 per month, with dedicated workspaces starting at \$550 and offices at \$700.

A HISTORY OF INNOVATION

The City of Gulfport came into existence at the turn of the 19th century largely through the efforts of Captain Joseph T. Jones, a self-made oil tycoon from Pennsylvania. Captain Jones purchased the Gulf & Ship Island Railroad to ship Yellow Pine across the country and built the Gulf & Ship Island Railroad building in 1902. Recognizing the need for more efficient distribution, he dredged the shipping channel that is still in use today by the Port of Gulfport.

The Gulf & Ship Island RR Building was restored in 1986. Coming full circle, today the GSI Building serves as the hub of the Gulf Blue Initiative and truly represents the past, present, and future of the blue economy.
